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Nusa Island Retreat is located just off the coast of Kavieng, New Ireland Province. Nusa Lik is just one of the myriad of islands that forms the majestic Bismarck Archipelago chain.

We suggest visiting [Air Niugini's site](#) (PNG's national carrier) for current schedules & access to their online booking portal.

Air Niugini operates daily domestic flights between Port Moresby (PNG'S Capital) & Kavieng (final destination).

Air Niugini offers regular services between Cairns, Brisbane & Sydney, AUSTRALIA.

They also fly Singapore, Manila & Hong Kong on certain days of the week.

If travelling from one of PNG's more regional locations, you may wish to check Airlines PNG who also operate a number of flights each week visit www.pngair.com.pg



If arriving by air, Kavieng Airport is a only 10 minute drive to the harbour where one of our boats will waiting to transfer you the short distance to Nusa Island Retreat.

We strongly recommend completing online check in for any Air Niugini flights.

FISHING

Kavieng has rewarded many a sportfisherman's expectations. There is a good range of fishing in the area, from estuarine mangrove systems to reefs and blue water fishing. Pelagics have proved to be the most popular pursuit, from the razor gang & GT's, through to the Tuna and Billfish.

Nusa Island Retreat (NIR) operates a range of 'open' Yamaha longboats that are primarily set-up for trolling the reefs edges, casting in the mangrove estuaries and around inshore bombies.

Should you require something a little more comfortable we have a Plate Aluminium boat with canopy (25foot) running a single 200Hp Yamaha. And more serious again - a Bluewater 2550 Centre Console Sportsfisher available for hire

Don't Forget - You will be in the tropics. So bring a wide-brim hat, long sleeve light cotton shirt and plenty of sunscreen!!

For the serious fisherman, it is encouraged that you bring your own equipment to match the style of fishing you require. The benefit of this, is that you know your expectations and the limitations of your own gear. A variety of hard bodied tremblers & minnows (i.e rapala / halco etc) in assorted colours and sizes will put you in good stead.....the most popular colours being the 'Qantas' (red/white); the 'Blu Pilly' (blue/silver) and the 'Bomber' (gold/black). A combo of shallow to mid-depth divers and deep diving lures is a good idea.

These lures are usually about 7"-8" and ensure they have good split rings & strong trebles. Oh Yeah, don't forget the wire trace / sages etc.....the 'Razor Gang' will be only too happy to add to their collection of lures!

There's no tackle shops up here so bring everything you'll likely need, from trace / sages / snaps / lures etc.

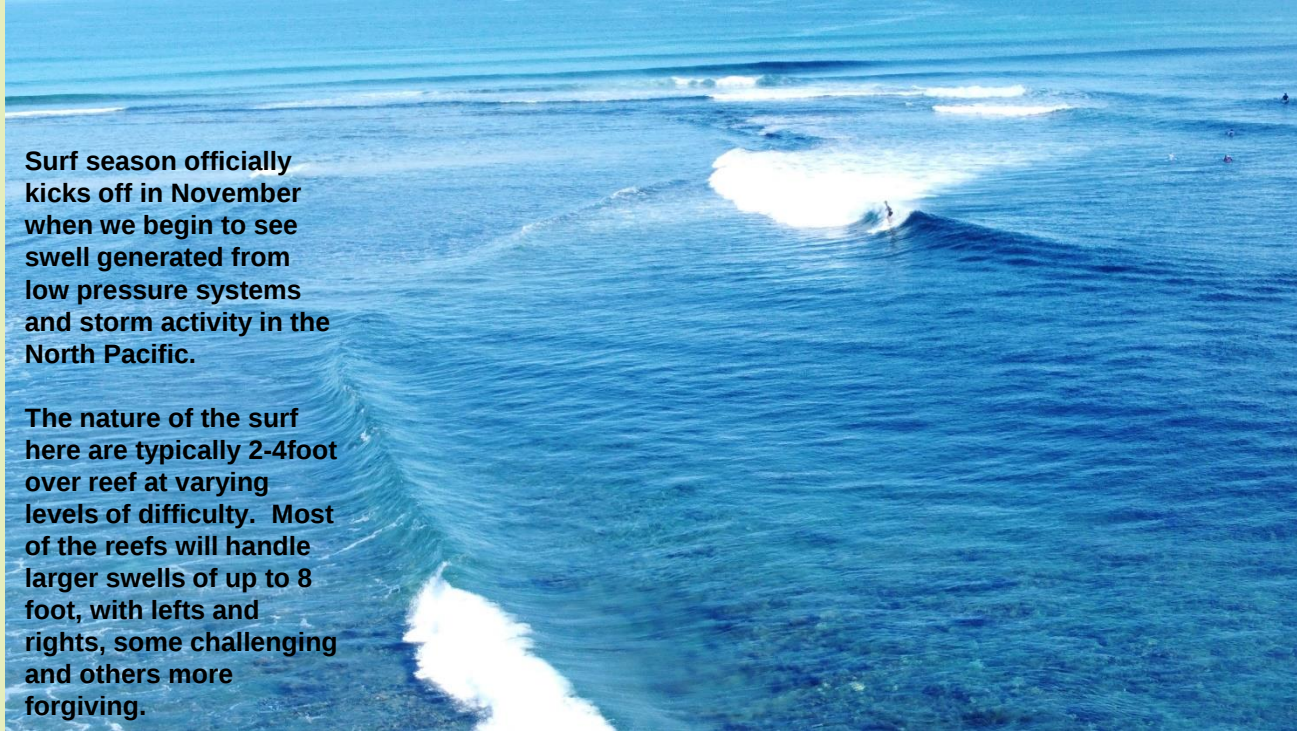
SURFING

Seasonal : November - April

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Surf season officially kicks off in November when we begin to see swell generated from low pressure systems and storm activity in the North Pacific.

The nature of the surf here are typically 2-4foot over reef at varying levels of difficulty. Most of the reefs will handle larger swells of up to 8 foot, with lefts and rights, some challenging and others more forgiving.



Local communities have custodial rights to and over these reefs, principally for hunting and gathering. As such, it is acknowledged that they retain traditional rights over these areas and in an effort to foster good working relationships and structured access agreements, **Surf Management Plans** have necessarily evolved to respectfully recognise and protect the interests of the various stakeholders.

IF PROPOSING TO SURF DURING YOUR STAY- YOU MUST BOOK YOUR SURF SPOT IN ADVANCE

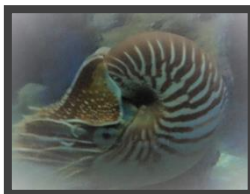
